ARMISTICE DAY 11/11/1918. . . 100 YEAR ANNIVERSARY

Originally called Armistice Day, this day marks the armistice signed between the Allies of World War I and Germany at Compiègne, France, for the cessation of hostilities on the Western Front of World War I, which took effect at eleven o'clock in the morning—the "eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month" of 1918. Armistice Day became a legal holiday and is now known as Veterans Day.

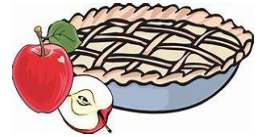
SAINT COLUMBA LADIES AUXILIARY
