OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE



The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, was instituted in 1925 by Pope Pius XI. He instituted the Feast of Christ the King in his encyclical letter Quas primas of 1925, in response to growing secularism.

While the encyclical that established this feast was addressed, according to the custom of the time, to the Catholic Bishops, Pope Pius XI wanted the Feast to impact the laity. He wrote: (excerpts)

"If to Christ our Lord is given all power in heaven and on earth; if all men, purchased by his precious blood, are by a new right subjected to his dominion; if this power embraces all men, it must be clear that not one of our faculties is exempt from his empire. He must reign in our minds, He must reign in our wills, which should obey the laws and precepts of God. He must reign in our hearts, He must reign in our bodies which should serve as instruments for the interior sanctification of our souls, or to use the words of the Apostle Paul, as instruments of justice unto God."

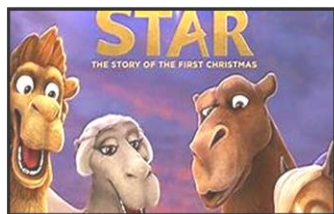
